Hannah Hopkins of Haddonfield, in the County of Gloucester (and State of New Jersey, being weak in body, but of sound mind, memory and understanding, do this twenty second day of the eighth month, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven (1837), make and publish this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say:—
It is my Will and the order, that all my just debts and several expenses be duly paid and satisfied out of my personal
